The Charles May Knives FireAnT -



The knife is 5 3/8" overall, with a 2 3/8" long D2 blade at 60rc. The blade is .125" thick and 1" wide, flat ground with a razor sharp and nicely polished beveled edge.

Handle scales shown are beautiful desert ironwood with mosaic pins and stainless thong hole liner. Although the handle is a hair less than 1/2" thick, it's meaty and offers phenomenal purchase and easy manipulation.

The sheath is designed solely for pocket carry and it slides into the pocket nicely and unobtrusively. There is very little signature in the pocket.
